When I moved from New Jersey to Connecticut three years ago, I found it very difficult to meet people. I was looking for a way to network and become familiar with the local businesses. I contacted the Milford Newcomer's Organization and found they were disbanded.

Soon after, I was asked if I wanted to revive the group. I decided to take the opportunity and recruited a few people to start the process. Later, the name was changed to Milford Community Connection to enable men, women and local businesses to become members.

The purpose of the group is for newcomers and existing residents of Milford to meet and form connections. The group also works in cooperation with other non-profit agencies in Milford in working towards serving the needs of the community. MCC has made donations to the Tsunami fund through the Milford American Red Cross, collected toys for the Yale New Haven Children's Hospital and has worked with the Beth El Center to assist single parents in need.
